# People and welfare



## Welfare

- The well-being of all those attending is really important to us!
- Our leaders are all DBS checked and will have completed required mandatory training ahead of the trip
- Our trip undergoes approval and risk assessment procedures, signed off at various levels
- We will have first aid trained leaders on the trip and a welfare team to look after medication/support for those attending
- We are planning to equip some of the team with mental health first aid training
- During the trip, young people will be in smaller groups with allocated leaders to support them, they will get to know the adults ahead of the trip

## Support for younger members

- We know at the pre-events and during the event build up, some attendees will still be in Cubs.
- Also during the trip itself we know the age range will be large from 10.5-17 years old
- However, we are experienced at working with this age range and supporting all those attending.
- Core trip team built with experience from across the age ranges- the age differences are considered at each stage

Specific support for younger participants includes:

- Pre-event programme activities in age groups (as well as activities in mixed age groups)
- Closer support during pre-events
- Integrating all ages and awareness of working as a team
- Small groups during the trip with allocated leaders

## Pre-event preparation

- 2 planned pre-camps
- 7-8<sup>th</sup> October 2023 – Hamlet Wood Scout Campsite
- 3-5<sup>th</sup> May 2024 – Lower Grange Farm
- Cost covered by the overall trip fee

# Finance

## Let's talk finance....

- £1,100 per participant

*This factors in foreign exchange rates sensitivities and fuel prices etc.*

*We have benchmarked this against similar trips being run by other Districts/Counties*

This will include:

- Travel
- Accommodation
- Catering
- Programme
- 2 x pre-events
- Insurance
- Merchandise- scarf, clothing and holdall

Only other points to factor in

- Clothing/personal kit
- Spending money for souvenirs etc
- Passport (if not already owned/expires prior to event)
- Optional add ons for merchandise
