

Alphabet Hunt

A Great Game to Play on Zoom!

Take it Further!

A good way to make this more challenging would be to decrease the time allowed to get each item.

Another rule you could add is to say that some common items don't count to make it more challenging!

Time: 20 Minutes

Preparation:

All you need to run this game is an alphabet and an imagination. You can come prepared with a few ideas for each letter also!

Equipment:

- Have a copy of the alphabet in front of you.
- Have a pen so when a letter is called it can be crossed off.
- Have a few items written down for each letter!



1

For this game you should say a letter of the alphabet, then your young people have a minute to find an item in their house which starts with that letter.

Next, start a 1 or 2 minute timer (depending on the age of your young people, and how much you want to challenge them)

Everyone who came back with an item starting with the correct letter gets 1 point and the most unique item gets a bonus point!

First, pick a letter of the alphabet, then when you're ready, tell your young people which letter you have chosen!

You don't have to do them in order, feel free to mix it up!

Once everyone has returned (or when the timer has finished) get everyone to hold up what they have found.

You should then give everyone who came back within the time 1 point.

Could one of the young people in your section lead this activity/game?
